'...I am doing a great work...' <u>Nehemiah 6:3</u>

Nehemiah was passionate about rebuilding Jerusalem's walls. So when his enemies tried to sidetrack and discourage him, he answered, '...I am doing a great work, so that I cannot come down...'



Passion is the starting point for all achievement. There has never been anyone who achieved anything of value, who wasn't passionate about it. It's the energy that fuels your dream.
