

If I speak in the tongues of men and angels, but have not love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. 1 Corinthians 13:1 Jesus says:


'If you love me, you will keep my commandments.' John 14:15 We cannot love our neighbour unless we love Jesus. We cannot love Jesus, unless we obey Him.
