

'I am doing a great work, so that I cannot come down.' Nehemiah 6:3 NKJV.

Success usually comes at the end of struggle; if it came easily, everybody would be experiencing it. When it comes to success, there are no shortcuts, reduced prices or 'special deals.' The value of anything is determined by the price you're willing to pay for it. And when you truly value something, you won't easily jeopardise it because you remember what it cost you.
