Narrow Is the Road

'But small is the gate and narrow and difficult to travel is the path that leads the way to [everlasting] life, and there are few who find it.' Matthew 7:14

Following God means walking the "narrow road." It means facing adversity. Here are several things I've learned that help me to keep going:

- 1. God's Word is a border for my life. As long as I stay within the guidelines laid out in Scripture, I'll have wisdom and understanding to know what I need to do and have what I need, in Christ, to do it. God is faithful and true to His Word.
- 2. I have to be willing to finish what I start. God uses committed people who aren't led by emotion. It's easy to be excited in the beginning when something is new, but the ones who cross the finish line are the ones who hang in there when no one else is excited anymore.
- 3. When no one is there to help me, I get to know Jesus really well. The narrow road of living for God and not conforming to the ways of the world is often lonely. But the trade-off of

gaining real intimacy with Christ is worth more than anything you could ever get from the world.
