

- 3. Choose one of these marks of maturity that especially challenges you at the moment. What does God want you to LEARN, DISCUSS and APPLY? Who could you talk with about it?
- 4. Look up Galatians 5:16-28. What is the BAD news and the GOOD news here?
- 5. Remember that we live by the Spirit (1) and God causes the growth (7). How do these facts encourage you today?

A Word from Andrew

One of the characteristics of living things is that they grow. From a tiny seed or embryo, a plant or animal emerges and develops according to their DNA, with the help of a supportive environment. As Christians, we have the "DNA" of Jesus! He has made us his children and begun his transforming work by His Spirit. Now we grow into maturity, as we take in God's Word and respond in repentance and obedience. But what if we get stalled in our journey? What if our behaviour fails to match our belief (or our walk doesn't match our talk)?

This is the challenging issue we address in 1 Corinthians 3 this week.
