We had 27 from both the CM and EM, as well as making a friend or two along the way... A great time was had by all -thanks Rob!!!

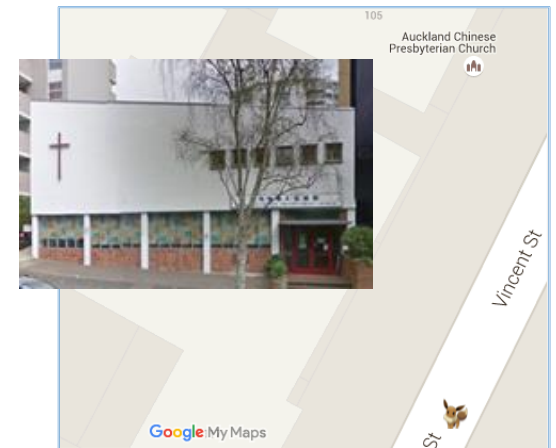

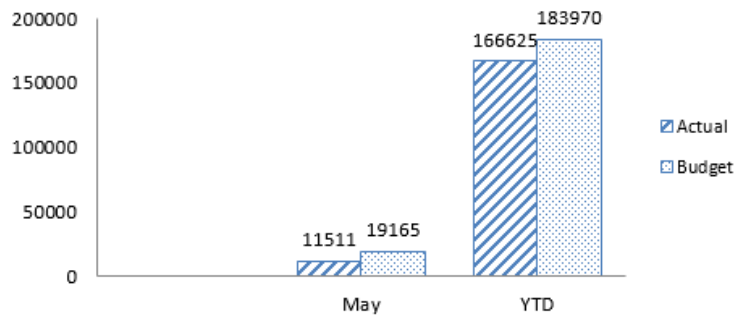

East Timor Mission Fundraising – Friday 5th August 6pm

Three fast facts about East Timor (Timor-Leste):

1. Population (2015): 1,167,242
2. Two official languages: Portuguese and Tetum
3. Adult literacy rate in 2010: 58.3%, up from just 37.6% in 2001



A lot of good work is going on in East Timor, but there's still more to be done! The dinner held at St Peter's Presbyterian Church (7 Harrison Road, Ellerslie) is for the One 2 One Timor Trust, that provides dental and medical aid and training to the East Timorese. The team plans to visit East Timor at the end of August and will take over essential equipment and medicines as well as provide training and treatment.
